- Food vendors must have a Business License, Montana State Food Purveyor's License, and liability insurance.
- Vendors and exhibitors must fill out the registration form (previous page) and be approved by MREA. You will be notified of your acceptance.
- MREA reserves the right to refuse exhibits which would detract from the purpose, dignity
 and intent of the Montana Clean Energy Fair. MREA reserves the right to stop or remove
 from the event any exhibitor who performs any practice deemed by MREA to be illegal,
 objectionable, or creates a health or safety hazard.
- Vendors and exhibitors are responsible for attending their booths at all times. MREA is not
 responsible for damages, theft, or loss to exhibitor displays or products displayed at the
 Montana Clean Energy Fair.
- Vendors and exhibitors agree to hold MREA harmless from any claim on account of any actions of the vendor/exhibitor, any injury to any person, or damage to any property.
