# 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Montana Clean Energy Fair <u>EXHIBITOR/VENDOR</u> REQUIREMENTS



- This event will follow all local and county health and safety requirements.
- Food vendors must have a Business License, Montana State Food Purveyor's License, and liability insurance.
- Vendors and exhibitors must fill out the registration form (previous page) and be approved by MREA. You will be notified of your acceptance.
- MREA reserves the right to refuse exhibits which would detract from the purpose, dignity
  and intent of the Montana Clean Energy Fair. MREA reserves the right to stop or remove
  from the event any exhibitor who performs any practice deemed by MREA to be illegal,
  objectionable, or creates a health or safety hazard.
- Vendors and exhibitors are responsible for attending their booths at all times. MREA is not
  responsible for damages, theft, or loss to exhibitor displays or products displayed at the
  Montana Clean Energy Fair.
- Vendors and exhibitors agree to hold MREA harmless from any claim on account of any
  actions of the vendor/exhibitor, any injury to any person, or damage to any property.
- Vendors and exhibitors shall comply with the laws, rules and regulations of the State of Montana, Yellowstone County, and City of Billings.
- Vendors and exhibitors agrees to allow MREA to use images, video and/or audio footage made of the exhibitor or exhibit for promotion of the Montana Clean Energy Fair.
- Vendors and exhibitors can begin setting up at 7:00 am on Saturday, August 12. We ask that vehicles used for loading/unloading be moved away from the fair site by 8:00 am. Booths must be set up by 8:30 am and remain open until 3:30 pm.
